“67% of mobile device users who visited a website which is not mobile friendly they feel like not to visit that website again”

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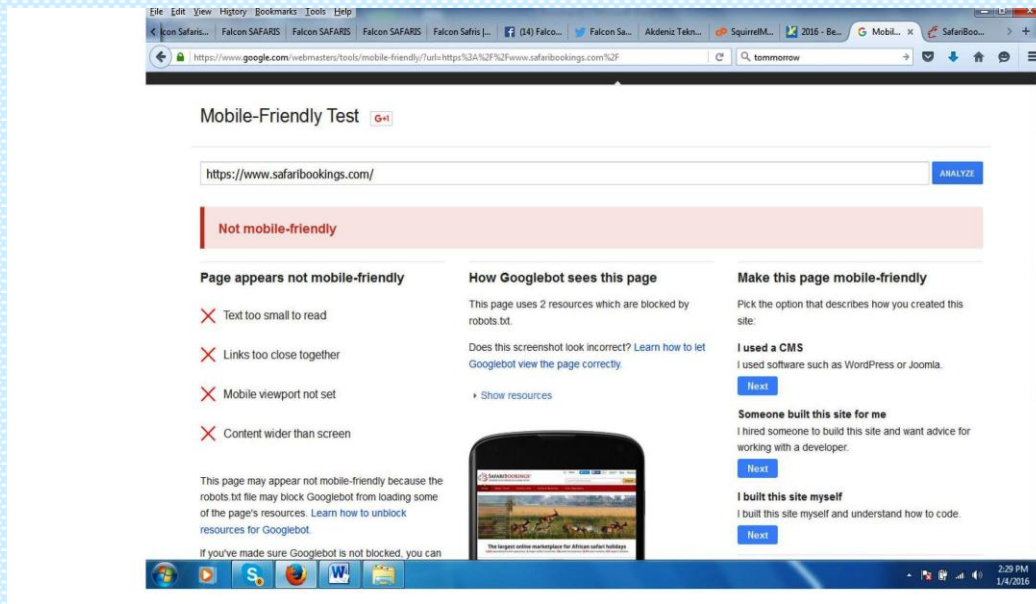
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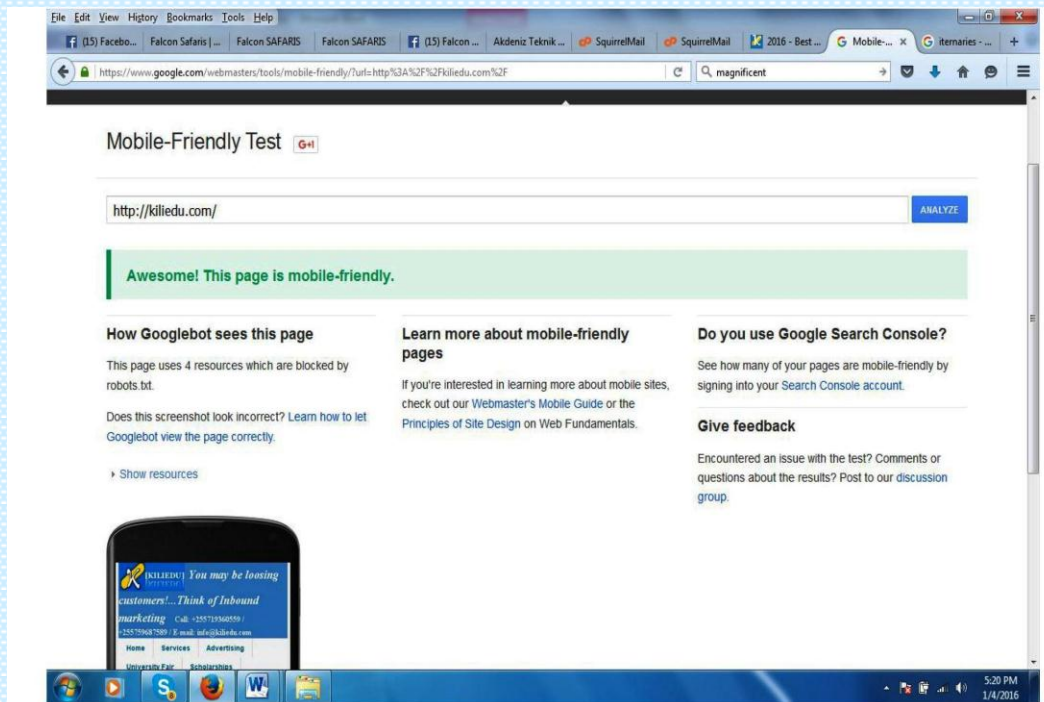
I. To check if your website is mobile friendly, insert your website link to the Google mobile friendly test below.

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2. Still you have to check the way your website pages respond through a web browser especially the Mozilla Firefox

- Open your website using Mozilla Firefox
- Go through Tools button on the menu bar
- Go through Web Developers
- Go through Responsive Design View
- Your website will now be covered with a thick black boundary;
- Start dragging your website slowly from the right side to the left side.
- If you start cutting the images, videos and text, it means that your images and videos are not responsive. The same thing will happen when a mobile device user opens your website.
